Corporations conducting business in the United States are cordially invited to apply for corporate membership. The **Marine Corps Intelligence Association, Inc.** is a non-profit, fraternal organization of Marine Corps Regular, Reserve, Retired, and Honorably Discharged Intelligence Marines, and Marine affiliated civilian intelligence professionals. We were incorporated on 10 November 1993 in the State of California in accordance with existing codes and statutes. We are approved by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax exempt war veterans organization under Section 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Our purpose as defined in our constitution is: (1) To foster fraternal relations among Regular, Reserve, Retired, and Former Marines, and members of the uniformed services who have honorably served in Marine Corps Intelligence; (2) To promote professionalism among the Marine Corps intelligence communities through collective action by its membership and through its affiliation with other associations; (3) To provide useful services to its members, their dependents, and/or survivors; and (4) To serve the Nation, the Marine Corps and the intelligence community.

The Association is recognized by the Secretary of the Navy, the Commandant of the Marine Corps, and the Assistant Chief of Staff for Command Control Communications Computers and Intelligence (C4I) at Headquarters, Marine Corps. The Association has been officially read into the Congressional Record in January 1994 by Congressman Robert K. Dornan, (R) CA. We are listed in the **Marine Corps Association Directory of Marine Related Organizations**, and are registered with the **Professional Intelligence Groups, Common Interest Network (The CIN List)**. However, the Association is in no way subject to administrative or operational control of any of these offices or organizations. Solely our elected Board of Directors, our by-laws, and all applicable Federal and State laws governs us.

Each year the Association holds an annual convention and reunion which includes a Board of Directors meeting, general business meeting, and an awards banquet and dinner-dance at host cities throughout the U.S. The Director, Central Intelligence, Assistant Chief of Staff for Command Control Communications Computers and Intelligence (C4I), and other high profile members of the Intelligence Community have graciously accepted our invitation to be the guest of honor at previous events.

Our quarterly newsletter, **The INTSUM**, and our annual **Membership Directory** is published for all active members. These publications are not official documents nor do they represent any official Marine Corps opinion.

Corporate membership is open to all corporations with principal headquarters in the United States of America, which supports our purpose as established in our constitution and by-laws.
